

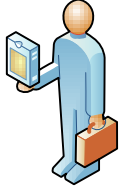
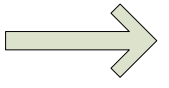

## How Planning Works

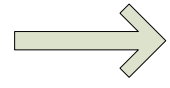

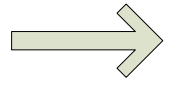
Residents draw up ideas and request plans to be made



Residents submit plans to New Forest District Council / NPA using the 'Planning Portal'

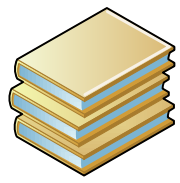


Plans are received by New Forest District Council / NPA and are handed to the relevant departments.

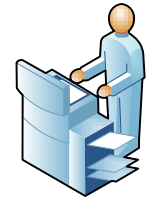
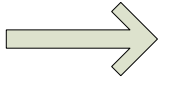


Planning application is assessed by NFDC / NPA, neighbours on the site boundary notified by a site notice put up nearby.

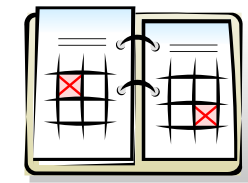
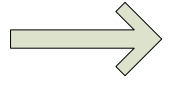

New Milton Town Council receives and assesses the applications, notifying the relevant ward members who may visit on site

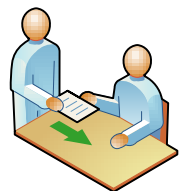


A list is produced to advertise which applications will be discussed at the next meeting.

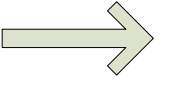


The meeting is held at the Town Hall, New Milton. Residents are welcomed to share their thoughts and opinions in the public participation section of the meeting

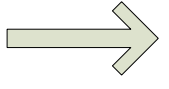
